- Purchase exiting, new, nature-inspired equipment, plus shade and accessibility features
- Refurbish current yellow playscape, designed for younger kids
- Retain treasured swing set, monkey bars and climbing dome





#1: Purchase Discovery Tree w/Slide to replace existing slide

- Multiple climbing options
- Fun, “sidewinder” slide
- Designed for older kids
- Durable environmentally friendly materials



#2: Add new shade & mobility features



Two Mobility Mats:

- Easier access for individuals with wheelchairs, walkers, strollers or wagons
- More families together on the playground

Two 16' x 16' shade/rain awnings:

- Reduce heat-related issues
- Withstand winds up to 90 mph and will fold, roll or lay out for winter storage

#3: Purchase new free-standing play options – add fun, fitness and climbing (Placed next to Discovery Tree Climb/Slide)



LOG CRAWL TUNNEL

- Place near existing bush
- Maximum fall height 41”



60”x 30”

LOG BALANCE BEAM

- 60” x 30”
- Maximum fall height 12”



LOG STEPPERS



ACORN SEATS

- 18” in diameter

#4: Refurbish hazards on yellow climbing structure

- Replace stairs
- Repair sharp rusty corners on the deck
